

## **Shared Services Comprehensive Community Services Initiative Outline of 2016 Regional Training Committee Priorities**

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### Development of a regional training plan:

- Provide as needed New Provider Orientation workshops
- Provide as needed 2-day Care Coordination / Team Facilitation workshops for new Service Facilitators
- Identify regional training needs at all levels – CCS staff (internal and external), consumers, community partners including Coordination Committee members, and community members
- Development of a monthly training schedule, with topics and presenters based on the needs of the region

### Partner with the Northeast Behavioral Health Partnership in their efforts to develop web-based CCS training modules

- Support use by providers in the four counties currently in the northeast region
- Advocate for use by providers in Adams and Juneau County (, and address barriers when possible
- Integrated the system into our website's current outline/process for orientation training

### Support provider development and shared services across the region

- Identify potential providers
- White Pine and county(ies) collaborate in the development of new providers
- Seek technical assistance from the DMHSAS and/or DQA as needed

### Comply with DQA's request for monthly shared services updates (May – October)
